Fraction Spoons Game

Prepare the Game:

- 1. Cut out all the cards as shown above. (If you print them on cardstock or heavy paper, it will be harder to see through the cards. You can also write your own on index cards cut in half.)
- 2. Count up the number of players, and subtract one. That's how many spoons you will need for this game.
- 3. Arrange the spoons in the center of a table.

Setting up to Play:

- 1. Shuffle the fraction game cards and deal out four cards for every player. Don't show anyone your cards!
- 2. The rest of the cards are next to the dealer in a pile.

Playing the Game:

- 1. The dealer takes the top card (they now have 5 cards) and removes one from their hand and passes it facedown to the player on their left. The dealer continues to take one card and gives one to the player on their left until the deck runs out.
- 2. The player on the left takes the discard from the dealer, selects one to pass on like the dealer.
- 3. This "pick one and pass one" continues around the circle. The last player always places their discards in a 'discard pile', these cards are out of the game.
- 4. When a player gets four fraction cards that are equivalent, they grab a spoon (try to do this without being noticed by the other players).
- 5. Once a player takes a spoon, everyone else immediately grabs a spoon, even if you don't have four of a kind yet.
- 6. The player without a spoon earns a letter from the word S-P-O-O-N-S.
- 7. The round is over and now you begin again.
- 8. Once a player earns all six letters of S-P-O-O-N-S they are out of the game.
